#### Consultation Response

The WNC Economic Development Officer has updated their response from supporting this application due to the creation of jobs to:

"Having reviewed this application further, I would like to clarify that I would only support this proposal if it were to result in a greater number of jobs created than the original use, since the use classes are comparable and therefore this would not be a better utilisation of the non-residential floorspace.

From an economic growth perspective, my focus is on ensuring that non-residential floorspace is utilised for the good of the economy and as many quality jobs are created to the benefit of local residents. If this application doesn't achieve either of these things, I would not be supportive of this proposal."

#### Proposed Use

Concerns have been raised to planning officers with regard to the report only considering the proposed use in relation to the housing of asylum seekers and

refugees, and not on the basis of a general large HMO/ Hostel use (Sui Generis). However, officers are content to determine the application on this basis since the submitted Planning Statement makes clear that the proposal is solely and specifically for this use. Officers therefore consider that any amendments to the proposed use, such as changing the proposed use to a general HMO or Hostel use would need to be subject to a fresh application.
