### WEST NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNCIL LICENSING SUB-COMMITTEE NOTIFICATION OF DETERMINATION

Application for the review of a Premises Licence in respect of premises known as The Crown Hotel, 20 Market Place, Brackley ("the Premises") under section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003.

# Applicant – The Chief Officer of Northamptonshire Police acting as Responsible Authority.

# Hearing Date – 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

The Licensing Sub-Committee ("the Sub-Committee") carefully considered the following:

- The written report and appendices prepared by Charlotte Lindop, Licensing Enforcement Officer;
- The application for the review of a premises licence ("the Application") made by the Chief Officer of Northamptonshire Police on the basis of the promotion of the licensing objective of the prevention of crime and disorder;
- The written representations of Woodfines Solicitors on behalf of the Premises License Holder, Colbert Wall Trading Limited;
- The written representations of Shoosmiths Solicitors on behalf of the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS), Mr Joao Maia e Silva;
- Oral representations opposing the Application made by Ms Morrisey, solicitor for the Designated Supervisor and Mr Hayward, solicitor for the Premises Licence Holder.
- The statutory guidance issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003, particularly paragraphs 11.24 through to 11.28.

# The Hearing

Both Ms Morrisey and Mr Hayward made preliminary representations to the panel as to whether it was necessary to proceed with the Hearing, making reference to section 52 of the Licensing Act 2003 and Regulation 9 of the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005 and the ability to agree to dispense with the hearing on agreement.

The Sub-committee received advice that it is the Licensing Authority's position that there is no provision for the Local Authority to dispense with a Review Hearing. Regulation 9 if the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005 can only be implemented when there is a provision within the Licensing Act 2003 to dispense with a hearing. That provision does not exist in relation to an application for a Review.

# Legal Advice

The Sub-committee received legal advice as follows:

- 1. Questions of fact are to be determined on the balance of probabilities.
- 2. The relevant licensing objectives raised in the representations are set out in the report.
- 3. The South Northants Statement of Licensing Policy 2020 contained no specific provisions in relation to the issues raised in the relevant representations before the Sub-Committee.
- 4. The options legally available to the Sub-Committee are set out in the report of the Licensing Officer.
- 5. Any action taken should be appropriate and proportionate and should be the minimum necessary in promote the licensing objectives, taking into account the evidence before the Sub-Committee.
- 6. The statutory guidance issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003.

## **Decision and Reasons**

The Sub-Committee the following findings of fact on the balance of probabilities.

- 1. The Applicant did not attend the Hearing in order to support the Review Application
- 2. The Applicant's letter of 12<sup>th</sup> October 2021 stated that having assessed the Application the evidence was insufficient to support any issues with the licensing objective of crime and disorder.

As a result, it would not be appropriate or proportionate to take any further action in this matter.

The Applicant, the Premises License Holder or any person that made a relevant representation in respect of this review of a Premises License may appeal against this decision to a Magistrates' Court within 21 days of receipt of a written copy of this decision.
