Following the publication of your response to the Fire & Rescue Statement for 2021/22, I am pleased to respond to the Panel in accordance with section 6 in accordance with the Police Reform & Social Responsibility Act 2011 Section 12 Paragraph 4(a).

I was very pleased that the panel commended the continuing progress and achievements reflected in the Fire & Rescue Statement for 2021/22. This was also recognised by Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary, Fire and Rescue Services (HMICFRS) who commended the service for the improvements it has made in keeping Northamptonshire safe.
